Daniel Rocznik is currently, Director, Standards with the American Chemistry Council (ACC) in Washington, DC. During his 25 years with ACC, Mr. Rocznik has assisted ACC member and Partner companies in the implementation of the Responsible Care® initiative in their operations. He manages ACC's Responsible Care third-party certification process which includes providing implementation assistance for companies preparing for certification; liaison with auditing firms and their accreditation bodies; and organizing training and workshops for ACC company personnel and third-party auditors. In addition to the ACC's certification program, Mr. Rocznik manages implementation of the ACC's Responsible Care Codes.

Mr. Rocznik also provides assistance to other associations in developing and enhancing their Responsible Care programs. Currently, he is working with the Indian Chemical Council, Pakistan Chemical Manufacturers' Association, Federation of Egyptian Industries and the Kenya Association of Manufacturers to enhance their existing Responsible Care programs.

Before joining ACC in 1993, Mr. Rocznik worked for several public policy consulting firms in the Washington DC area assisting clients to better understand the workings of public interest groups active on issues such as environmental protection; consumer rights; biotechnology and genetic engineering; shareholder activism and animal welfare.
